**13 SEP 2023 : CHANDIGARH – KAPURTHALA (165 KMS - 4 HRS ONE WAY )**

**Today early morning at 0700 AM drive to Kapurthala**

#### **SPOT 01: 1115 – 1200 HRS**

**Jagatjit Palace** Head to the grand Palace of the former Maharaja of Kapurthala, the Jagatjit Palace. It is spread over an area of 200 acres with distinct French influence on its architecture. Designed in 1906, the palace is clearly inspired by Versailles and Fontainebleau. It currently houses the Sainik School.

#### **SPOT 02: 1215 – 1300 HRS**

**Darbar Hall, Kapurthala**, Then to Darbar Hall, Kapurthala, it is going to be leased out on PPP mode for developing it as a boutique heritage hotel. The stately Darbar Hall stands proudly at the very centre of the city. It was at one time the Court of Maharaja Jagatjit Singh. It was in this majestic building that he used to receive the people of his kingdom, listen to their woes and render justice. The Maharaja's annual birthday celebration and other state rituals and ceremonies were also held here. Existing heritage structure is proposed to be used as Heritage hotel cum restaurant. Having Reception & Lounge, Restaurant and 8 rooms.

#### **SPOT 03: 1315-1400 HRS**

**Gol Kothi, Kapurthala**, was originally known as "Kamra Kothi". It was built by Raja Fateh Singh in the year 1833 A.D and was used as a residence by the Maharajas of Kapurthala. His Highness Maharaja Jagatjit Singh resides here from the age of seven in 1879 A.D. to the age

of eighteen. When Maharaja Jagatjit Singh shifted his residence from here, it became the 'Indian Guest House. This existing structure and be developed as Heritage Restaurant cum Recreation Center with facilities including indoor & outdoor sport like billiards, chess, table tennis - tennis court/squash court, recreation, health, fitness & Wellness, lodging and accommodation etc.



**1400 – 1500 HRS: LUNCH AT PREFIX VENUE**

**SPOT 04: 1515 – 1545 HRS**

**Elysee Palace.** Across the road is the Elysee Palace. Built in 1862 by Kanwar Bikram Singh, in the Indo-French style architecture. The Palace is a famous monument in the city with its magnificent façade and monolithic structure. Today this structure has been converted into the MGN School.
